
#### **BLOCK ASSEMBLY**

All seams are 1/4".

- 1. 4-Patch Unit: Sew (1) A and F 3" strip together. Press toward A. Make (3) strip sets. Subcut (32) 3" x 5-1/2" rectangles from the strip sets.
- 2. Sew (2) Step 1 rectangle units together, as shown. Square to 5-1/2". Make (16) 4-Patch Units.



**3.** Half-Square Triangle (HST) Unit: Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (8) **F** 6" squares. With right sides together, place an **F** square atop an **E** 6" square. Sew a 1/4" seam allowance on each side of drawn line. Cut along drawn line to yield (2) HST units; press toward **E**. Square to 5-1/2". Make (16).



**4.** Arrange (2) **4-Patch** and (2) **HST** units together, as shown. First, sew together into horizontal rows and press each row toward HSTs. Then, sew rows together to complete block. Press seam in one direction. Square to 10-1/2". Make (8).



**5.** Repeat **Step 3** using (4) **C** and (4) **D** 11" squares. Square to 10-1/2". Make (8).





**6.** Square-in-a-Square Block: Sew (1) **E** triangle onto one edge of (1) **C** 7-5/8" square, as shown. Press toward **E**. Sew a second triangle onto opposite edge of the **C** square and press toward triangle. Repeat with remaining sides to make block. Square to 10-1/2". Make (4).

#### **QUILT ASSEMBLY**


**7.** Referring to **Quilt Assembly** diagram on **page 5**, sew blocks and fabric squares together into horizontal rows and press each row in opposite directions. Sew rows together and press in one direction to complete quilt center.

#### **BORDER**

**8.** Trim selvages from the (5) **B** 5-1/2" border strips and, along with the 5-1/2" x 29-1/2" border strip, sew strips together end-to-end using straight seams. Cut (2) 5-1/2" x 50-1/2" border strips and sew to each side of quilt center. Press toward border. Then cut (2) 5-1/2" x 60-1/2" borders strips and sew top and bottom edges of quilt center. Press toward borders to complete quilt top.



### **QUILT ASSEMBLY**



**FINISHING:** Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich. Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using **E** 2-1/2" strips.
