## Materials

1 panel Panel - Multi (A)
1 yard Snowflake - White/Red (B)
2/3 yard Swirl - White/Gray (C)
$5 / 8$ yard Snowflake - Red (D)
$5 / 8$ yard Buffalo Check - Blk/White (E)
1 yard Swirl-Red (F)
$11 / 3$ yards Snowflake - Black (G)
$1 / 4$ yard $\quad$ Stocking Allover - Red (H)
$33 / 4$ yards Doves - Red (Backing)

## Cutting Instructions

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Panel - Multi (A):

- Fussy cut (15) $71 / 2 "$ blocks.

From the Snowflake - White/Red (B), cut:

- (6) 2 " $\times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (30) $2 " \times 7 \frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- (8) 2 " x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (30) 2" x 10 1/2" strips.


## From the Swirl - White/Gray (C), cut:

-(5) $31 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (60) $31 / 2 "$ squares.
From the Snowflake - Red (D), cut:
-(8) $2 "$ x WOF strips.
From the Buffalo Check - Blk/White (E), cut:
-(8) $2 "$ x WOF strips.

## From the Swirl - Red (F), cut:

- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 " x $541 / 2 "$ strips.
- (3) 2 " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $2 " \times 481 / 2 "$ strips.
-(7) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips for the binding.
From the Snowflake - Black (G), cut:
- (3) $51 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $51 / 2 " \times 571 / 2 "$ strips.
- (3) $51 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $51 / 2 " \times 481 / 2 "$ strips.


## From the Stocking Allover - Red (H), cut:

-(1) $51 / 2 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (4) $51 / 2 "$ squares.

## From the Doves - Red (Backing), cut:

-(2) $66 " x$ WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the $66 " \times 75 "$ back.

Sewing Instructions

1. Sew (1) $2 " \times 71 / 2 "$

Fabric B strip to each side of (1) $71 / 2 "$ Fabric A block. Sew (1) 2 " x $10 \frac{1}{2 \prime}$ " Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A block. Trim the block to measure $91 / 2$ " square to make (1) Block One (Fig. 1). Repeat to make (15) Block Ones total.

2. Sew (1) $2 " x$ WOF Fabric E strip and (1) $2 " x$ WOF Fabric D strip together lengthwise to make (1) ED strip set (Fig. 2). Repeat to make (8) ED strip sets total.
3. Cut the ED strip sets into (150) $2 " \times 31 / 2 "$ ED strips (Fig. 3).
4. Sew (2) ED strips together to make (1) Unit 1 block (Fig. 4). Repeat to make (75) Unit 1 blocks total.

5. Sew (1) $31 / 2 "$ Fabric C square to each side of (1) Unit 1 block to make (1) middle row. Sew (1) Unit 1 block to each side of (1) $31 / 2$ " Fabric C square. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the middle row lengthwise to make (1) Block Two (Fig. 5). Repeat to make (15) Block Twos total.

## Quilt 1

Quilt Top Assembly (Refer to the Quilt Layout while assembling.) 6. Sew (3) Block Ones and (2) Block Twos together, alternating them, to make Row One. Repeat to make Rows Three and Five.
7. Sew (3) Block Twos and (2) Block Ones together, alternating them, to make Row Two. Repeat to make Rows Four and Six.
8. Sew the (6) rows together in numerical order to make the Center Block.
9. Sew (1) 2 " $\times 541 / 2 "$ Fabric F strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2" x $48 \frac{1}{2} "$ Fabric F strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
10. Sew (1) $5 \frac{1}{2} " \times 571 / 2 "$ Fabric G strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $51 / 2 "$ Fabric H square to each end of (1) $5 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 481 / 2 "$ Fabric G strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.
11. Layer and quilt as desired.
12. Sew the (7) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF Fabric F strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
13. Bind as desired.
