2 yards $\quad$ Small Toy Tossed - Cream (C) 766-44
$11 / 2$ yards Folio Basics - Christmas Green (D) 7755-66
$11 / 4$ yards Ornament - Black (E) 767-99
$11 / 2$ yards Tossed Allover Bell - Cream (F) 764-44
2/3 yard $\quad$ Nutcracker - Black (G) 761-99
$7 / 8$ yard $\quad$ Saint Nick - Cream (H) 768-44
$2 / 3$ yard Twinkle - Gold Yellow (I) 135-43
$1 / 2$ yard $\quad$ Scenic - White (J) 762-01
$73 / 4$ yards Scenic - White (Backing) 762-01
*Includes binding

## Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

## From the 36 Inch Pillow Block Panel - Cream (A):

- Fussy cut (4) 15 1/2" squares, each centered on a block.


## From the Plaid - Red (B), cut:

-(1) $67 / 8 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) $67 / 8 "$ squares and
(4) $61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares.

- (2) $61 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) $61 / 2 "$ squares.
- (4) $2 "$ x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) $2 " \times 151 / 2 "$ strips.
- (4) $2 "$ x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) $2 " \times 181 / 2 "$ strips.
- (1) $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 15 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ strips.
- (1) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 171 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips.
-(9) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strips for the binding.


## From the Small Toy Tossed - Cream (C), cut:

-(6) $6 \frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) $61 / 2 "$ x $121 / 2 "$ strips.

- (10) 3 " x WOF strips. From each strip sub-cut (1) 3 " x $221 / 2 "$ strip and (1) $3 " \times 171 / 2 "$ strip.

From the Folio Basics - Christmas Green (D), cut:

- (3) $61 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) $61 / 2 "$ squares.
- (10) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ x $221 / 2$ " WOF strips.
-(10) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ x $241 / 2$ " WOF strips.
From the Ornament - Black (E), cut:
- (12) $31 / 2 " \times 241 / 2 "$ WOF strips.

From the Tossed Allover Bell - Cream (F), cut:

- (1) $67 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) $67 / 8 "$ squares.
-(12) $31 / 2 " \times 241 / 2 "$ WOF strips.
From the Nutcracker - Black (G), cut:
-(3) $61 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) $61 / 2 "$ squares.
From the Saint Nick - Cream (H), cut:
- (2) $121 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (4) $121 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Twinkle - Gold Yellow (I), cut:
-(3) $6 \frac{112 "}{2 \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) $61 / 2 "$ squares.
From the Scenic - White (J), cut:
-(1) $151 / 2 "$ square.
From the Scenic - White (Backing), cut:
-(3) 92 " x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the $92 " \times 92 "$ back.

## Block Assembly

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Sew (1) $2 " \times 15 \frac{1}{2} "$ Fabric B strip to each side of (1) $151 / 2 "$ Fabric A square. Sew (1) $2 " \times 181 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A square to make (1) Unit 1 square (Fig. 1). Trim the block to measure 17 1/2" x 17 ½". Repeat to make (4) Unit 1 squares total.

2. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2} " \times 15 \frac{1}{2} /{ }^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric B strip to each side of (1) $15 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric J square. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 171 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric J square to make (1) Unit 2 square (Fig. 2).
3. Sew (1) 3" $\times 17 \frac{1}{2} "$ Fabric C strip to each side of (1) Unit 1 square. Sew (1) $3 " \times 221 / 2 "$ Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 1 square to make (1) Unit 3 square (Fig. 3). Repeat to make (4) Unit 3 squares total.


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4. Sew (1) 3 " $\times 171 / 2 "$ Fabric C strip to each side of (1) Unit 2 square. Sew (1) $3 " \times 221 / 2 "$ Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 2 square to make (1) Unit 4 square (Fig. 4).
5. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 221 / 2 "$ Fabric D strip to each side of (1) Unit 3 square. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 241 / 2 "$ Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 3 square to make (1) Unit 5 square (Fig. 5). Repeat to make (4) Unit 5 squares total.

6. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 221 / 2 "$ Fabric D strip to each side of (1) Unit 4 square. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 241 / 2 "$ Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 4 square to make (1) Block One square (Fig. 6).

7. Place (1) $67 / 8 "$ Fabric B square on top of (1) $67 / 8 "$ Fabric F square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Fig. 7). Sew $1 / 4 "$ away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 7). Cut the (2) squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 8) to make (2) halfsquare triangles. Trim the half-square triangles to measure $6^{1 / 2 "}$ square to make (2) Unit 6 squares (Fig. 9). Repeat to make (4) Unit 6 squares total.

8. Sew (1) $31 / 2 " \times 241 / 2 "$ Fabric F strip to the top of (1) $31 / 2 " \times 241 / 2 "$ Fabric E strip lengthwise to make (1) $61 / 2 " \times 241 / 2 "$ Unit 7 strip (Fig. 10). Repeat to make (12) Unit 7 strips total.

9. Sew (1) Unit 7 strip to the left side of (1) Unit 5 square. Sew (1) Unit 6 strip to the left end of (1) Unit 7 strip. Sew the newly sewn strip to the top of the Unit 5 square to make (1) $301 / 2 "$ Block Two square (Fig. 11).

10. Repeat Step 9 and refer to Figures 12-14 for component identification, placement and orientation to make (1) Block Three square, (1) Block Four square and (1) Block Five square.

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11. Place (1) $6^{1 / 2 "}$ Fabric B square on the top left corner of (1) $121 / 2 "$ Fabric H square, right sides together (Fig. 15). Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 15). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle $1 / 4 / 4$ away from the sewn seam (Fig. 16).

12. Follow Figure 17 for the seam direction to add a $61 / 2$ " Fabric B square to each of the remaining corners of the $121 / 2 "$ Fabric H square to make (1) Unit 8 square (Fig. 18).
13. Repeat Steps 11-12 to make (4) Unit 8 squares total. Unit 8 make 4

14. Place (1) $61 / 2 "$ Fabric D square on the left side of (1) $61 / 2 " \times 121 / 2 "$ Fabric C strip, right sides together (Fig. 19). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 19). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance (Fig. 20).

15. Place (1) $6 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric I square on the right side of the $6^{1 / 2 "} \times 121 / 2 "$ Fabric C strip, right sides together (Fig. 21). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 21). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance to make (1) Unit 9 strip (Fig. 22).
16. Repeat Steps 14-15 to make (16) Unit 9 strips total.

17. Sew (1) $61 / 2 "$ Fabric G square to each end of (1) Unit 9 strip to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) Unit 9 strip to each side of (1) Unit 8 square to make the middle row. Sew together the (3) rows lengthwise to make (1) Unit 10 square (Fig. 23). Repeat to make (4) Unit 10 squares total.

18. Sew (1) Unit 7 strip to the bottom of (1) Unit 10 square to make (1) $241 / 2 " \times 301 / 2 "$ Block Six rectangle (Fig. 24).

19. Repeat Step 18 and refer to Figures 25-27 for component identification, placement and orientation to make (1) Block Seven rectangle, (1) Block Eight rectangle and (1) Block Nine rectangle.

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Quilt Top Assembly (Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.) 20. Sew together (1) Block Two square, (1) Block Six rectangle and (1) Block Three square, in that order from left to right, to make the top row.
21. Sew together (1) Block Seven rectangle, (1) Block One square and (1) Block Eight rectangle, in that order from left to right, to make the middle row.
22. Sew together (1) Block Four square, (1) Block Nine rectangle and (1) Block Five square, in that order from left to right, to make the bottom row.
23. Sew together the (3) Rows lengthwise to make the quilt top.
24. Layer and quilt as desired.
25. Sew the (9) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF Fabric B strips together, end to end with 45 -degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
26. Bind as desired.
