$1 / 8$ yard Acorns and Flowers - Pumpkin (F) 2530-35
$11 / 8$ yards Moonshine Border Stripe - Black (G) 2534-99
$1 / 2$ yard Star Flowers - Charcoal (H) 2531-98

-(1) 17 " square pillow form •(1) $18 "$ square pillow form

## Cutting Instructions

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.
From the Crow Blocks - Black (A), fussy cut:

- (1) 11 " $\times 15$ " rectangle, centered on the crow on the fence.
- (4) $71 / 4 " \times 7 \frac{1}{4}$ " squares, each centered on a small crow.

From the Bias Weave Texture - Black (B), cut:

- (1) $13 / 4$ " $\times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) $13 / 4$ " x $171 / 2 "$ strips.
- (1) $11 / 2 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) $11 / 2 "$ squares.
- (1) $11 / 4 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) $11 / 4 " \times 15 "$ strips.
- (1) 1 " x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 1" x $15 "$ strips.
-(1) $1 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (10) $1 " \times 21 / 2 "$ strips.
-(2) $1 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (2) $1 " \times 231 / 2 "$ strip and
(2) $1 " \times 6 \frac{1}{2} "$ strips

From the Moonshine Vine - Black (C), cut:

- (1) $11 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (12) $11 / 2 "$ squares.
- (2) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (4) $11 / 2 " \times 141 / 2 "$ strips.
- (1) 1 " x WOF strip. Sub-cut (1) $1 " \times 141 / 2 "$ strip and
(2) 1 "x $71 / 4 "$ strips.

From the Moonshine Vine - Pumpkin (D), cut:

- (1) $121 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) $121 / 2 " \times 171 / 2 "$ strips.
- (1) 1 " x WOF strip. Sub-cut (24) 1 " x $11 / 2 "$ strips.
- (2) 1 " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 1" x $21 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Crows and Wildflowers - Gold (E), cut:

- (1) $71 / 2 " \times$ Length of Fabric (LOF) strip. Sub-cut
(2) $71 / 2 " \times 1 \frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- From the remaining fabric, cut (2) 2 " x $251 / 2 "$ WOF strips, and (4) $1 \frac{1}{2} / 2 \times 141 / 2 "$ WOF strips.
- (1) $13 \stackrel{1}{2}$ " $\times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) $131 / 2 " \times 181 / 2 "$ WOF strips.

From the Acorns and Flowers - Pumpkin (F), cut:

- (1) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ squares.

From the Moonshine Border Stripe - Black (G), fussy cut:

- (2) $33 " \times 21 / 2 "$ LOF strips, each centered on a row of leaves.
- (1) $221 / 2 " \times 61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ LOF strip, centered on a row of crows.
- (2) $18^{\prime \prime} \times 21 / 2 "$ LOF strips, each centered on a row of leaves.

From the Star Flowers - Charcoal (H), cut:

- (1) $141 / 2 " \times 291 / 2 "$ WOF strip.

Pillow \#1 Assembly

1. Sew (1) 1" x 15 " Fabric B strip to each side of the 11 " x 15 " Fabric A rectangle to make (1) Unit 1 rectangle (Fig. 1).

2. Sew (1) $1 " \times 11 / 2 "$ Fabric D strip to each side of (1) $11 / 2 "$ Fabric C square. Sew (1) $1 " \times 21 / 2 "$ Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric C square to make (1) Unit 2 square (Fig. 2). Repeat to make (12) Unit 2 squares total.

3. Sew (6) Unit 2 squares and (5) 1 " $\times 21 / 2 "$ Fabric B strips together, alternating them, to make (1) Unit 3 strip (Fig. 3). Repeat to make a second Unit 3 strip.
4. Sew (1) Unit 3 strip to each side of the Unit 1 rectangle. Sew (1) $11 / 4 " \times 15 "$ Fabric B strip to each side of the Unit 1 rectangle. Sew (1) $13 / 4 " \times 171 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 1 rectangle to make the Pillow \#1 top.

10. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 141 / 2 "$
5. Turn under the $17 \frac{1}{2}$ " edge of (1) $121 / 2$ " $\times 17 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D strip approximately $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$, press and repeat to make a finished edge on (1) edge of the Fabric D strip. Repeat with the second $121 / 2 " \times 17 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D strip.
6. Position and pin each back envelope flap, right sides together with the pillow front, overlapping the finished edges in the middle and aligning the raw edges with the pillow front (Fig. 5). Stitch around the pillow front and back to complete the pillow.
7. Turn the pillow right side out and add the pillow form.

## Pillow \#2 Assembly

8. Sew (1) $71 / 4 "$ Fabric A square to each side of (1) $1 " \times 71 / 4 "$ Fabric C strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of (1) $1 " \times 141 / 2 "$ Fabric C strip to make (1) Unit 4 square (Fig. 6).

9. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B square to the left side of (1) $11 / 2 "$ Fabric F square to make the top row. Sew (1) $11 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric F square to the left side of (1) $11 / 2$ " Fabric B square to make the bottom row. Sew the (2) rows together to make (1) Unit 5 square (Fig. 7). Repeat to make (4) Unit 5 squares total.


Fig. 5 Fabric E and (1) $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 141 / 2 "$ Fabric C strip together lengthwise and in that order to make the Left Side Border (Fig. 8).
11. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 14 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C and (1) $11 / 2 " \times 141 / 2 "$ Fabric E strip together lengthwise and in that order to make the Right Side Border (Fig. 9). Border (Fig. 10).
13. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 14 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric E strip to the bottom of (1) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 14 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C strip lengthwise to make the Bottom Border (Fig. 11).
14. Sew the Left Side Border and Right Side Borders to the left and to the right side of the Unit 4 square (Fig. 12). (Fig. 12).
16. Sew (1)

Unit 5 square to each end of the Bottom Border. Sew the newly sewn strip to the bottom of the Unit 4 square to

12. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 14 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ Fabric E strip to the top of (1) $11 / 2 " \times 141 / 2 "$ Fabric C strip lengthwise to make the Top

15. Sew (1) Unit 5 square to each end of the Top Border. Sew the newly sewn strip to the top of the Unit 4 square make the Pillow \#2 top (Fig. 12).

17. Turn under the $181 / 2$ " edge of (1) $131 / 2 " \times 181 / 2 "$ Fabric E strip approximately $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$, press and repeat to make a finished edge on (1) edge of the Fabric E strip. Repeat with the second $131 / 2 " \times 181 / 2 "$ Fabric E strip.
18. Position and pin each back envelope flap, right sides together with the pillow front, overlapping the finished edges in the middle and aligning the raw edges with the pillow front (Fig. 13). Stitch around the pillow front and back to complete the pillow.

19. Turn the pillow right side out and add the pillow form

## Pillow \#3 Assembly

20. Sew (1) 1 " $\times 61 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to each side of the $221 / 2 " \times 61 / 2 "$ Fabric G strip. Sew (1) $1 " \times 231 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric G strip to make (1) Unit 6 strip (Fig. 14).

21. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 71 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric E strip to each side of the Unit 6 strip. Sew (1) $2 "$ x $251 / 2 "$ Fabric E strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 6 strip to make (1) Unit 7 strip (Fig. 15).
