1 yard	Pearl Grid - Black (A)	L8089-99
¼ yard	Squarish Linework - White/Silver Foil (B)	8517A-09
¼ yard	Stars - White/Silver Foil (C)	8518A-09
¼ yard	Dots - White/Silver Foil (D)	8519A-09
¼ yard	Tossed Squares - White/Silver Foil (E)	8516A-09
¼ yard	Squarish Linework - White/Gold Foil (F)	8517A-03
¼ yard	Stars - White/Gold Foil (G)	8518A-03
¼ yard	Dots - White/Gold Foil (H)	8519A-03
¼ yard	Tossed Squares - White/Gold Foil (I)	8516A-03

You will also need:

- 20" pillow form

Pillow #1 Cutting Instructions

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage unless otherwise noted.

From the Pearl Grid - Black (A), cut:

- (25) Template 1 triangles.
- (25) Template 3 triangles.
- (1) 13" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (2) 13" x 20 ½" strips.

From the Squarish Linework - White/Silver Foil (B), cut:

- (3) Template 2 triangles.
- (1) Template 3 triangles.

From the Stars - White/Silver Foil (C), cut:

- (4) Template 2 triangles.

From the Dots - White/Silver Foil (D), cut:

- (2) Template 2 triangles.

From the Tossed Squares - White/Silver Foil (E), cut:

- (3) Template 2 triangles.

From the Squarish Linework - White/Gold Foil (F), cut:

- (3) Template 2 triangles.

From the Stars - White/Gold Foil (G), cut:

- (1) Template 1 triangle.
- (3) Template 2 triangles.
- (1) Template 3 triangle.

From the Dots - White/Gold Foil (H), cut:

- (3) Template 2 triangles.

From the Tossed Squares - White/Gold Foil (I), cut:

- (1) Template 1 triangle.
- (2) Template 2 triangles.

Pillow #1 Sewing Instructions

1. Place (1) Fabric A-Template 1 triangle on top of (1) Fabric G-Template 1 triangle, right sides together, aligning the left sides (Fig. 1). Sew the (2) triangles together along the left side. Press the triangle open to make (1) AG unit (Fig. 2).

2. Repeat Step 1 using Fabric A-Template 1 and Fabric I-Template 1 to make (1) AI unit (Fig. 3).

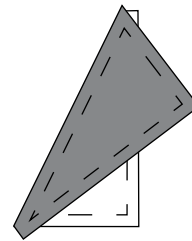

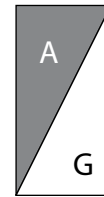

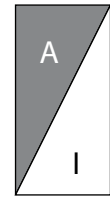

3. Place (1) Fabric A-Template 3 triangle on top of (1) Fabric B-Template 3 triangle, right sides together, aligning the right sides (Fig. 4). Sew the (2) triangles together along the right side. Press the triangle open to make (1) BA unit (Fig. 5).

4. Repeat Step 3 using Fabric G-Template 3 and Fabric A-Template 3 to make (1) GA unit (Fig. 6).

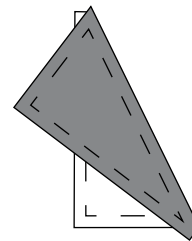

5. Place (1) Fabric A-Template 1 triangle on top of (1) Fabric B-Template 2 triangle, right sides together, aligning the left sides (Fig. 7). Sew the (2) triangles together along the left side. Press the smaller triangle open.

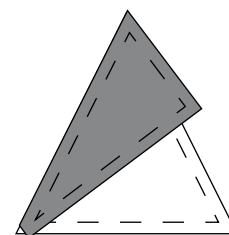

6. Place (1) Fabric A-Template 3 triangle on top of the Fabric B-Template 2 triangle, right sides together, aligning the right sides (Fig. 8). Sew the (2) triangles together along the right side. Press the smaller triangle open. Trim the block to measure 4 1/2" square to make (1) ABA unit (Fig. 9).

7. Repeat Steps 5-6 to make (3) ABA units total.

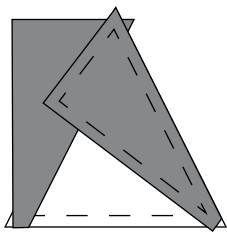

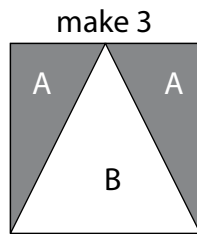

8. Repeat Steps 5-6 and use Figures 10-16 for fabric identification and location to make the designated number of 4 1/2" units. There are (23) units total.

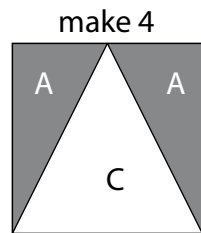

9. Sew (5) assorted 4 1/2" units together to make Row One. Repeat to make Rows Three and Five (Fig. 17).

10. Sew (1) GA unit, (4) assorted 4 1/2" units and (1) AG together in that order to make Row Two (Fig. 17).

11. Sew (1) BA unit, (4) assorted 4 1/2" units and (1) AI unit together in that order to make Row Four (Fig. 17).

12. Sew the (5) rows together, in numerical order, to make Pillow #1 top (Fig. 17).

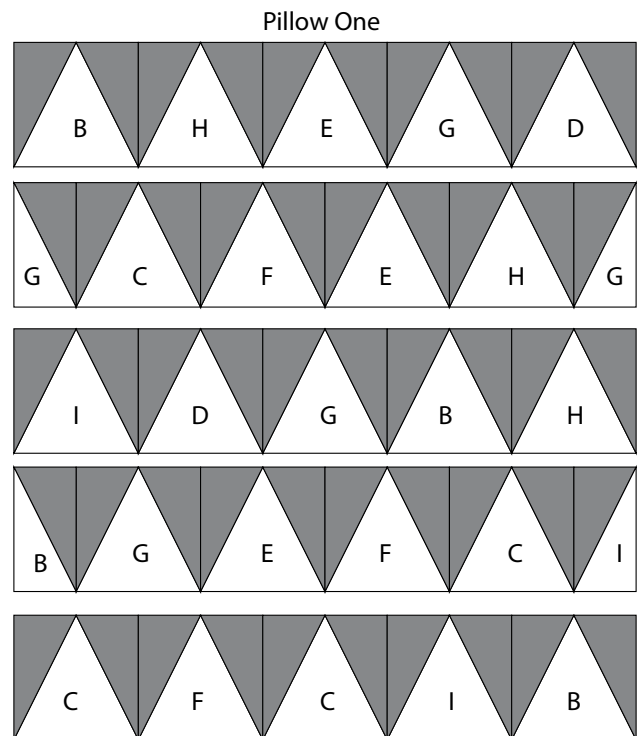

13. To make the back envelope flaps, turn under the 20 1/2" edge approximately 1/4" press and repeat. Topstitch to make a finished edge on one edge of the 13" x 20 1/2" Fabric A piece. Repeat with the second 13" x 20 1/2" Fabric A piece.

14. Position and pin the each back envelope flap, right sides together with the pillow front, overlapping the finished edges in the middle and aligning the raw edges with the pillow front (Fig. 18). Stitch around the pillow front and back to complete the pillow.

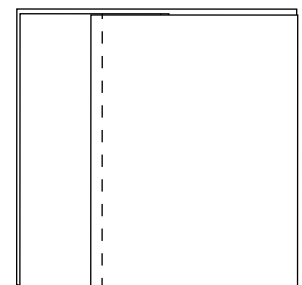

15. Turn the pillow right side out.

Pillow #2 Cutting Instructions

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage unless otherwise noted.

From the Pearl Grid - Parchment (A), cut:

- (2) 3 ⅞" x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (20) 3 ⅞" squares.
- (1) 12 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (2) 12 ½" x 18 ½" strips.

Fabric B, cut:

- (1) 3 ⅞" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (5) 3 ⅞" squares.

Fabric C, cut:

- (1) 3 ⅞" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (5) 3 ⅞" squares.

Fabric D, cut:

- (1) 3 ⅞" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (5) 3 ⅞" squares.

Fabric E, cut:

- (1) 3 ⅞" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (5) 3 ⅞" squares.

Pillow #2 Sewing Instructions

1. Place (1) 3 ⅞" Fabric A square on top of (1) 3 ⅞" Fabric B square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Fig. 19). Sew ¼" away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 19). Cut the (2) squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 20) to make (2) half-square triangles. Trim blocks to measure 3 ½" square to make (2) AB units (Fig. 21). Repeat to make (10) AB units total. *Note: Only 9 units will be used.*

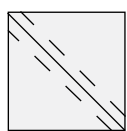

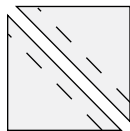

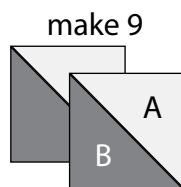

2. Repeat Step 1 and use Figures 22-24 for fabric identification and make ten 3 ½" units of each combination. *Note: Only 9 of each combination will be used.*

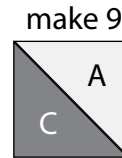

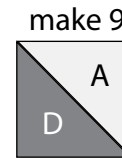

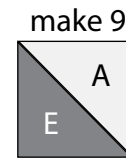

3. Sew (6) assorted 3 ½" units together to make (1) row. Repeat to make (6) rows.

4. Sew the (6) rows together to make the pillow top (Fig. 25).

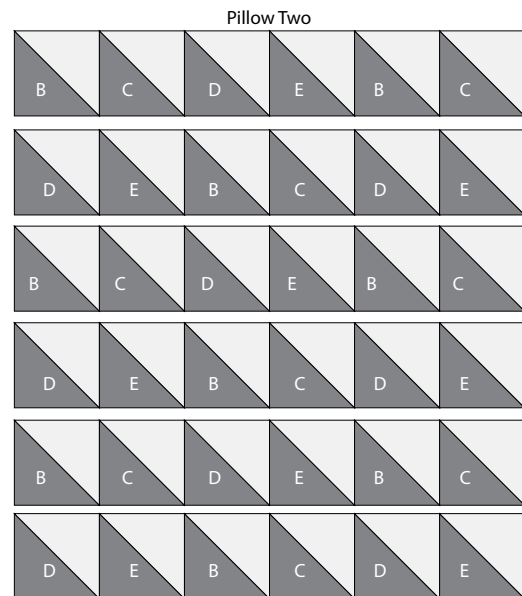

5. To make the back envelope flaps, turn under the 18 ½" edge approximately ¼" press and repeat. Topstitch to make a finished edge on one edge of the 12 ½" x 18 ½" Fabric A piece. Repeat with the second 12 ½" x 18 ½" Fabric A piece.

6. Position and pin the each back envelope flap, right sides together with the pillow front, overlapping the finished edges in the middle and aligning the raw edges with the pillow front (Fig. 26). Stitch around the pillow front and back to complete the pillow.

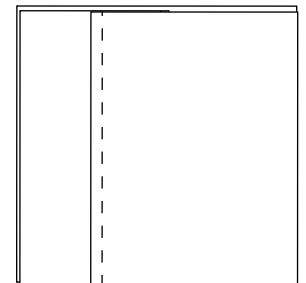


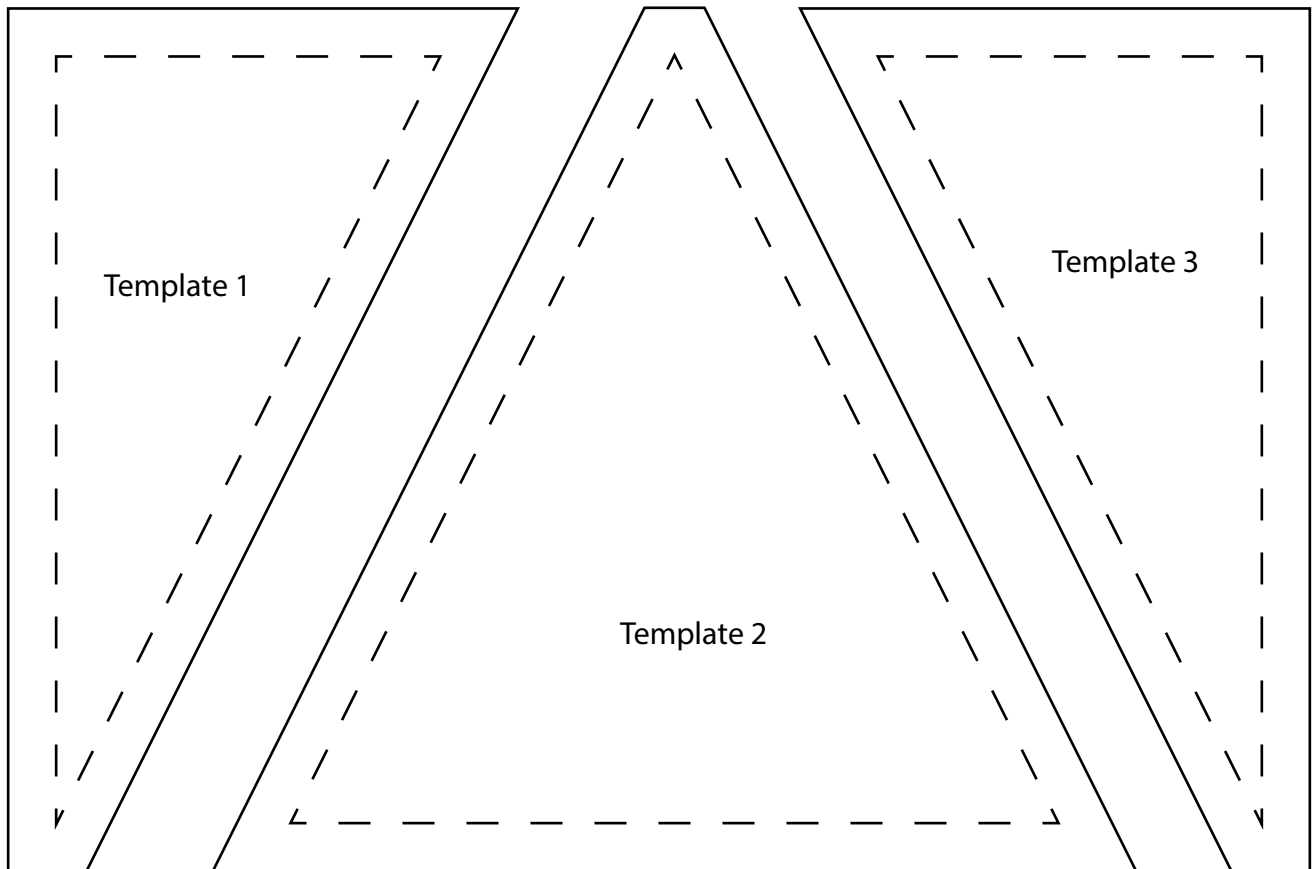
