

# INDIGO COTTAGE Quilt 3

### **Quilt Materials**

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1 panel	Embroidery Blocks - Royal (A)	2115-77
$1^{1/3}$ yards	Border Stripe - Royal (B)	2116-77
⅓ yard	Ditsy Daisy - Royal (C)	2123-77
1 yard	Ditsy Daisy - Royal (Backing)	2123-77

\*Includes binding

### **Quilt Cutting Instructions**

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

**From the Embroidery Blocks - Royal (A), fussy cut:** • (6) 6 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" blocks.

### From the Border Stripe - Royal (B), cut:

(2) 2 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 30" Length of Fabric (LOF) strips.
(2) 2 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 22" LOF strips.
(2) 2 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 14 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" LOF strips.
(3) 2 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 6 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" LOF strips.

From the Ditsy Daisy - Royal (C), cut:

• (3) 2 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Ditsy Daisy - Royal (Backing), cut:

• (1) 26" x 34" strip for the back.

### **Quilt Top Assembly**

### (Refer to the Quilt Layout while assembling.)


1. Sew (1) 6 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" Fabric A block to each side of (1) 2 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 6 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" Fabric B strip lengthwise to make (1) row. Repeat to make (3) rows.

2. Sew together the (3) pieced rows and (2)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $14\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strips lengthwise and alternating them to make the Center Block.

3. Center (1)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 30" Fabric B strip on (1) side of the Center Block and pin in place. Start sewing the strip a  $\frac{1}{4}$ " from the top edge of the block and stop a  $\frac{1}{4}$ " from the bottom edge. **DO NOT TRIM THE EXCESS.** Repeat with the opposite side.

4. Repeat Step 3 to sew (1)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 22" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block, making sure to stop and start  $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from each end of the block. To miter each corner, fold the Center Block on a diagonal, wrong side together. This should line up the strips from adjacent sides (Fig. 1).


5. Starting at the sewn seam (represented by the arrow in Figure 1), draw a 45-degree line to the edge of the fabric. Sew on the drawn line. Trim the excess fabric leaving a <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" seam. Repeat this step with the remaining corners to make the quilt top.



6. Layer and quilt as desired.

7. Sew the (3)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF Fabric C strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

8. Bind as desired.

#### **Pillow Materials**

½ yard	Border Stripe - Royal (A)	2116-77
<sup>1</sup> ⁄ <sub>4</sub> yard	Ditsy Daisy - Royal (B)	2123-77
1/2 yard	Large Plume - Royal (Backing)	2117-77

### You Will Also Need:

• Poly Fil Stuffing

### **Pillow Cutting Instructions**

*Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric* (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

### From the Border Stripe - Royal (A), fussy cut:

• (3) 5 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" x 12 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" Length of Fabric (LOF) strips.

### From the Ditsy Daisy - Royal (B), cut:

• (2) 2 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (4) 2 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 12 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" strips.

### From the Large Plume - Royal (Backing), cut:

• (1) 12 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 22 <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" strip for the back.

### **Pillow Top Instructions**


(*Refer to the Pillow Layout while assembling.*) 9. Sew together (4) 2 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 12 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" Fabric B strips and

9. Sew together (4)  $2\frac{1}{2}$  x 12  $\frac{1}{2}$  Fabric B strips and (3) 5  $\frac{1}{4}$  x 12  $\frac{1}{2}$  Fabric A strips lengthwise and alternating them to make the pillow top.

10. Sew together the pillow top and backing right sides together leaving a 4" opening for turning.

11. Turn the pillow rights sides out and stuff using the poly fil.

12. Whip stitch the opening closed.
