1 panel 24 Inch Ark Panel - Multi (A) 914P-11
$3 / 4$ yard ( 0.69 m ) Bias Plaid - Multi (B) 911-14*
$1 / 2$ yard ( 0.46 m ) Tossed Raccoons - Beige (C) 909-44
$5 / 8$ yard ( 0.58 m ) Modern Melody Basics - Cream (D) 1063-40
$1 / 4 \operatorname{yard}(0.23 \mathrm{~m})$ Moons, Stars and Clouds - Blue (E) 910-11
$1 / 4 \operatorname{yard}(0.23 \mathrm{~m}) \quad$ Tossed Arks - Blue (F) 906-11
$1 / 3$ yard ( 0.31 m ) Modern Melody Basics - Camel (G) 1063-31
$21 / 8$ yards ( 1.95 m ) Animal Stripe - Multi (H) 912-11
$31 / 4$ yards ( 2.98 m ) Moon, Stars and Clouds - Beige (Backing) 910-44

## Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the 24 Inch Ark Panel - Multi (A):

- Fussy cut (1) $221 / 2 " \times 421 / 2 "$ rectangle, centered on the panel.

From the Bias Plaid - Multi (B), cut:
-(2) 2 " $\times 42 \frac{1}{2} "$ WOF strips, piece as needed.

- (2) $2 " \times 251 / 2 "$ WOF strips.
- (6) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strips for the binding.

From the Tossed Raccoons - Beige (C), cut:

- (2) $41 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (4) $41 / 2 " \times 191 / 2 "$ strips.
- (1) $4 \frac{1}{2 \prime}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $41 / 2 " \times 91 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Modern Melody Basics - Cream (D), cut:
-(4) $11 / 2 "$ x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) $11 / 2 " \times 191 / 2 "$ strips.
-(2) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) $11 / 2 "$ x $91 / 2 "$ strips.

- (3) $11 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 581 / 2 "$ strips.
- (2) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 401 / 2 "$ WOF strips.

From the Moons, Stars and Clouds - Blue (E), cut:

- (1) $6 \frac{1}{2} / \prime$ x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $61 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Tossed Arks - Blue (F), cut:
-(1) $6 \frac{1}{2} ’$ "x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $61 / 2 \prime$ squares.
From the Modern Melody Basics - Camel (G), cut:

- (3) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $1 \frac{1}{2} " \times 561 / 2 "$ strips.
-(2) $11 / 2 " \times 381 / 2 "$ WOF strips.
From the Animal Stripe - Multi (H), cut:
- (2) $41 / 2 " \times 72 "$ Length of Fabric (LOF) strips.
-(2) $41 / 22^{\prime \prime} \times 52 "$ LOF strips.

From the Moon, Stars and Clouds - Beige (Backing), cut:
-(2) $56 "$ x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the $56^{\prime \prime} \times 76 "$ back.

Block Assembly
Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction.
Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Sew (1) $2 " x 421 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to each side of the $221 / 2 " \times 421 / 2 "$ Fabric A rectangle. Sew (1) 2" x $251 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A rectangle to make the Center Block (Fig. 1). Trim the block to measure $241 / 2 "$ x $441 / 2 "$.

2. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 191 / 2 "$ Fabric D strip to each side of (1) $41 / 2 " \times 191 / 2 "$ Fabric C strip lengthwise to make (1) $61 / 2 " \times 191 / 2 "$ Block One strip (Fig. 2). Repeat to make (4) Block One strips total.
3. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 91 / 2 "$ Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of (1) $4^{1 / 2 "} \times 91 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric C strip lengthwise to make (1) $6^{1 / 2 "} \times 91 / 2 "$ Block Two strip (Fig. 3). Repeat to make (4) Block Two strips total.

4. Sew (1) Block One strip to the top and to the bottom of (1) $6^{1 / 2 "}$ " Fabric E square to make (1) Side Border (Fig. 4). Repeat to make a second Side Border.
5. Sew together (1) $6 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric F square, (1) Block Two strip, (1) $61 / 2$ " Fabric E square, (1) Block Two strip and (1) $61 / 2$ " Fabric F square, in that order from left to right, to make the Top Border (Fig. 5). Repeat to make the Bottom Border.

## Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.) 6. Sew (1) Side Border to each side of the Center Block.
7. Sew the Top Border and the Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
8. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 56^{1 / 2 "}$ Fabric G strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{1 / 2 "} \times 381 / 2 "$ Fabric G strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
9. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 581 / 2 "$ Fabric D strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 401 / 2 "$ Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
10. Center (1) $41 / 2 " \times 72 "$ Fabric H strip on (1) side of the Center Block and pin in place. Start sewing the strip a $1 / 4 "$ from the top edge of the block and stop a $1 / 4$ " from the bottom edge. DO NOT TRIM THE EXCESS. Repeat with the opposite side.
11. Repeat Step 10 to sew (1) $41 / 2 " \times 52 "$ Fabric H strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block, making sure to stop and start $1 / 4$ " away from each end of the block. To miter each corner, fold the Center Block on a diagonal,
wrong side together. This should line up the strips from adjacent sides (Fig. 6).
12. Starting at the sewn seam (represented by the arrow in Figure 6), draw a 45 -degree line to the edge of the fabric. Sew on the drawn line. Trim the excess fabric leaving a $1 / 4 "$ seam. Repeat this step with the remaining corners to make the quilt top.

13. Layer and quilt as desired.
14. Sew the (6) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF Fabric B strips together, end to end with 45 -degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
15. Bind as desired.
