

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS:

- A. Pattern #22558-Mul1.....1/3 yard
- B. Pattern #22560-Mul1.....2/3 yard
- C. Pattern #22561-Bla1.....1/8 yard
- D. Pattern #22561-Pin1.....1/8 yard
- E. Pattern #22562-Mul1.....1/4 yard
- F. Pattern #22563-Bla1.....1/2 yard
- G. Pattern #22563-LtBlu1.....1/4 yard
- H. Pattern #22563-Pin1.....3/8 yard
- I. Pattern #22564-LtBlu1.....1/4 yard
- J. Pattern #22564-Tan1.....1/8 yard
- K. Pattern #22565-Bei1.....1/8 yard
- L. Pattern #22566-Mul1.....3/4 yard
- M. Pattern #22567-LtBlu1.....1/4 yard
- N. Pattern #22559-Tan1.....1 yard
- Batting.....1 piece 36" x 36"

3. Fussy cut one piece 18 1/2" x 2 1/2", beginning 1/4" above the cupcake band and ending 1/4" below the brown stripe below the cupcakes. Label "W".



C. Pattern #22561-Bla1 (Set stripe)

1. Cut one piece 24 1/2" x 1 1/4", label "F".



D. Pattern #22561-Pin1 (Set stripe)

Please note that because this fabric is striped, special attention to cutting is necessary!

1. Cut three rectangles 3 1/2" x 2", label "O".



2. Cut four 2 3/8" squares. Subcut two of these squares in half on the diagonal beginning at the lower right corner and ending at the upper left corner. Label three of these triangles "M". Subcut the remaining two squares in half on the diagonal beginning at the lower left corner and ending at the upper right corner. Label three of these triangles "M". (You will need a total six triangles of this color labeled "M".)



CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS:

Please read all instructions carefully before beginning. All seams are a scant 1/4" which is included in all measurements and templates unless otherwise stated. Cut pieces in order listed. Label all pieces. Refer to all illustrations and the quilt image for proper cutting and assembly. Templates, which are found in a separate document named "Cupcakery Quilt and Templates", are to be placed and traced on the right side of the fabric. (The dark line on the template is the sewing line and the dotted line is the cutting line.)

A. Pattern #22558-Mul1 (Patch print)

1. Fussy cut two pieces 3 1/2" x 4 1/4", label "Q". Use any 2 patches you choose.



B. Pattern #22560-Mul1 (Shelf print)

1. Fussy cut one piece 24 1/2" x 2 1/4", beginning 1/4" above the dark brown line and ending 1/2" below the scallop. Label "D".



2. Fussy cut one piece 8 1/2" x 2 1/8" beginning 1/2" above the beige background of the word "CUPCAKERY" and ending 1/4" below the horizontal brown stripe. Label "V".




E. Pattern #22562-Mul1 (Stripe cupcakes)

1. Fussy cut two pieces 2" x 5". The first piece should be cut beginning 1/4" to the left of the dot band and ending 1/4" to the right of the striped band. The second band should be cut 1/4" to the left of the striped band and ending 1/4" past the dot band. Label these "U".




- Fussy cut two pieces 1 3/4" x 8 3/4". The first piece beginning 1/4" to the left of the brown dot band and ending 1/4" to the right of flower band. The second piece beginning 1/4" to the left of the flower band and ending 1/4" past the dot band. Label "N".



F. Pattern #22563-Bl1 (Dot)

- Cut a rectangle 25 1/4" x 5 1/2". Mark a dot on the top at each end of the rectangle 5 1/2" from each short end. Cut off a triangle from the lower corners to the marks made on the top of the rectangle. See below. Label "X".



- Cut one of template "H" & template "J".
- Cut 4 strips 3" x width of fabric for binding.

G. Pattern #22563-LtBlu1 (Dot)

- Cut two pieces 8 1/2" x 4", label "A".
- Cut one piece 8 1/2" x 2 3/8", label "B".
- Cut one square 5 7/8" then cut in half on the diagonal for two triangles. Label "C".
- Cut two rectangle 8 1/2" x 2 1/4", label "E".

H. Pattern #22563-Pin1 (Dot)

- Cut two pieces 1 1/2" x 24" for the side inner borders.
- Cut two pieces 1 1/2" x 26 1/2" for the top and bottom inner borders.
- Cut four rectangles 4 1/4" x 1 1/4", label "P".

I. Pattern #22564-LtBlu1 (Text)

- Fussy cut one of template "T", making sure that the text is horizontal to the wide base of the template.



J. Pattern #22564-Tan (Text)

- Fussy cut two pieces 3 1/2" x 1 1/4", centering the larger, darker word "CUPCAKERY" in the rectangle. Label "R".

K. Pattern #22565-Bei1 (Recipe collage)

- Cut three 2 3/8" squares. Subcut these squares in half on the diagonal for a total of six triangles. Label "M".
- Cut four pieces 5" x 1 1/4", label "L".
- Cut four 1 1/4" squares, label "S".

L. Pattern #22566-Mul1 (Cupcakes on platters)

- Cut two pieces 3 5/8" W x 26" L for the side outer borders.
- Cut two pieces 33" W x 3 5/8" L for the top and bottom outer borders.
- Fussy cut one piece 3 1/2" x 5" label "T".



M. Pattern #22567-LtBlu1 (Tossed cupcakes)

- Cut one of template "G" & template "K".

N. Pattern #22559-Tan1 (Patch)

- Cut one piece 38" x 38" for the backing.

PIECING INSTRUCTIONS:

Refer to Quilt Image and Key Block for accuracy.

- Join "B" to "V" so that "B" is above the work "CUPCAKERY".




- Join an "A" piece to each short end of the "B-V" unit.



- Join a "C" piece to each end of "X" matching the long side of "C" to the angled edges of "X".



4. Join "D" to the long edge of "X" so that the awning scallop is facing away from "X".




5. Join the "sky/CUPCAKERY" unit above the roof unit, label "Section 1".



6. Join a "U" to each side of "T" making sure to orient the pieces correctly.



7. Join one "M" (pink, stripe piece) to alternate color "M" (recipe collage piece). Repeat for a total of six units. (Please note that you will have three left units and three right units.)




8. Join one left "M" unit to the left side of an "O", and one right "M" unit to the right side of "O". Repeat for a total of three and label "valance".



9. Join a "valance" to the top of the "UTU" unit from step 6. Label "door unit".




10. Join an "R" to the bottom of "Q" making sure to orient the fabrics correctly. Repeat for a total of two.



11. Join "P" to "S". Repeat for a total of four.



12. Join "L" to left side of the "PS" unit twice making two units. Join "L" to the right side of the "PS" unit twice, again making two units. These are the side window units.



13. Join a left side window unit (Step 12) to the left side of the "QR" unit (Step 10). Join the right side window unit to the right side of the "QR" unit. Then join a "valance" unit to the top to complete the window. Make 2 and label "window units".




14. Join one "window unit" to the left side of the "door unit" and the other window unit to the right side.



15. Join "W" to the top of the window + door + window unit from step 14.



16. Join an "N" piece to the right side of an "E" piece. Then join the remaining "N" to the left side of the remaining "E" piece. These are the building edges. (Pay strict attention to the direction of the fabric.)



17. Join the left building edge to the left side of the window + door + window unit (step 14), then join the right side of the building edge to the right side of the window + door + window unit.



18. Join piece "F" to the bottom of the unit from step 16. Label "Section 2".



19. Join "J" to the right side of "K". Join "H" to the left side of "G".



20. Join the JK unit to the left side of "I" and the "HG" unit to the right side of "I". Label "Section 3".



QUILT ASSEMBLY:

1. Join "Section 1" to the top of "Section 2" then join "Section 3" to the bottom of "Section 2".

BORDERS:

1. Add the inner side borders then add the inner top and bottom borders.
2. Add the outer side borders then the outer top and bottom borders.

FINISHING:

1. Layer the quilt top with the batting and backing.
2. Quilt as desired.
3. Trim the backing and batting even with the quilt top.
4. Sew binding strips end to end with a diagonal seams for form one long strip. Press lengthwise, wrong side together. Apply binding to quilt with a half inch seam allowance.
