Fabric Requirements



Stamps J8632-Tidepool **Fat Quarter**



J9000-Sand 1 yard



J8633-Sea Cliff **Fat Quarter**



Seaside Collage J8630-Tidepool 1 yard (extra yardage included for fussy cutting patches)

Sandpipers J8631-Tidepool

J8634-Rattan* 1-1/8 yards

J8634-Seamist 1/2 yd

½ yard

Backing 3 1/2 yards

Cutting

From the Stamps fabric, cut:

6 (6" x 6") J squares

From the Sea Cliff fabric, cut:

6 (6" x 6") J squares

From the Sandpipers fabric, cut:

[note: although all four patches are the same size, they are oriented in different directions—2 horizontally and 2 vertically. Cut your patches accordingly.] 4 (6" x 14") F rectangles

From the Seamist fabric, cut:

5 (3" x WOF) strips, pieced end-to-end and recut into 2 (3" x 48-1/2") side borders and 2 (3" x 53-1/2") borders

From the Sand fabric, cut:

4 (1-1/4" x WOF) strips, recut EACH into 1 (1-1/4" x 16-1/2") E rectangle and 3 (1-1/4" x 8-1/2") H rectangles

8 (1-1/4" x WOF) strips, recut EACH into 2 (1-1/4" x 15") D rectangles and 1(1-1/4" x 8-1/2") H rectangle

6 (1-1/4" x WOF) strips, recut into 24 (1-1/4" x 8-1/2") H rectangles

6 (1-1/4" x WOF) strips, recut into 32 (1-1/4" x 7") L rectangles

From the Seaside Collage fabric, cut:

[note: position elements in the centers of these patches because they are block centers] 2 (14") A squares 2 (6" x 14") F rectangles 4 (6") J squares

From the Rattan fabric, cut:

8 (1" x WOF) strips, into 44 (1" x 7") G rectangles 5 (1" x WOF) strips, into 32 (1" x 6") K rectangles 6 (1" x WOF) strips, into 16 (1" x 14") B rectangles 2 (1" x WOF) strips, into 4 (1" x 15") C rectangles 6 (2-1/4" x WOF) strips for binding

Key to Abbreviations


WOF = Width of Fabric; cut perpendicular to selvedge LOF = Length of Fabric; cut parallel to selvedge

Sewing

1. Block One. Diagram I.

Sew rattan fabric B rectangles to sides of A square. Sew rattan fabric Cs to top and bottom. Press all seams toward rattan fabric.

Add sand fabric D rectangles to sides, E rectangles to top and bottom. Press seams toward rattan fabric.



Make a total of two blocks

2. Block Two. Diagram II.

Sew rattan fabric B rectangles to top and bottom of F rectangle. Sew rattan fabric Gs to sides. Press all seams toward rattan fabric.

Add sand fabric D rectangles to top and bottom, H rectangles to sides. Press seams toward rattan fabric.




Diagram II

Make two blocks with sandpiper fabric (F) patches in a horizontal orientation and two with (F) patches in a vertical orientation. Make two blocks with seaside collage fabric (F) patches in a horizontal orientation.

2. Block Three. Diagram III.

Sew rattan fabric K rectangles to top and bottom of a J square. Sew rattan fabric Gs to top and bottom. Press all seams toward rattan fabric.

Add sand fabric L rectangles to sides, H rectangles to top and bottom. Press seams toward rattan fabric.




Make a total of 16 blocks.

Quilt Assembly

- 1. Refer to *Quilt Assembly Diagram* and quilt image for block layout. You'll sew together the blocks into four sections, then, sew together the sections.
- 2. Sew the (3" x 48-1/2") seamist fabric borders to opposite sides of the quilt. Add the remaining seamist borders to the remaining sides.

Finishing

- 1. Cut the backing into one (62" x WOF) panel. Split the remainder of the backing fabric in half, parallel to selvedge, so you have 2 rectangles approximately 20-21" wide. Sew these together end-to-end, then trim to 62". Sew to the (62" x WOF) panel, pressing seams open.
- 2. Layer top, batting, and backing. Quilt as desired. Bind

with the rattan fabric 2-1/4" wide strips.
